Boom Aerial Theory

This course will provide the participant with the necessary theoretical knowledge of proper aerial boom lift operation. It is the first part of a two-part requirement to become a qualified boom work platform operator.

- Understand and be familiar with the Operating Maintenance and Parts Manual and Operator's Manual provided by the manufacturer for the specific make and model he or she will be using
