Joint Health and Safety Committees are the backbone for health and safety in workplaces. Knowing what those responsibilities are and how members fulfill their roles is the focus of this course.

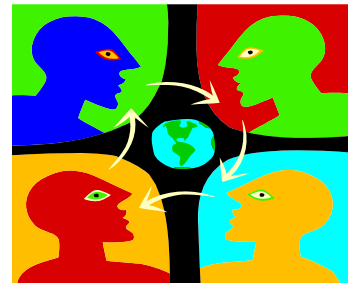
Participants will:
