Participants will:

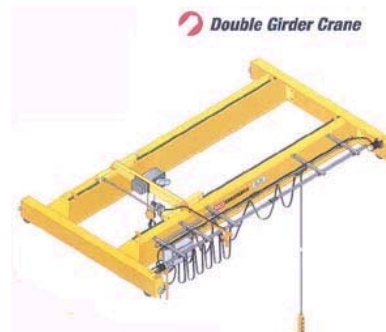
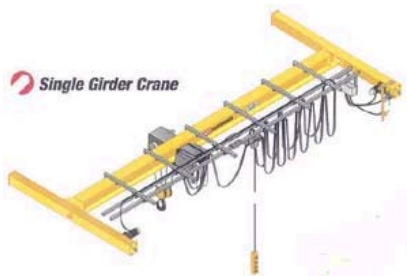
